


1	Annexure-1: Bill of Quantities (BOQ)	<p>We request clarification regarding the Grand Summary Sheet provided in the Price Bid Schedule (JICA).</p> <p>As per our understanding:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Row A represents the total quoted amount for DSR items and Non-Schedule items.</li> <li>Row B includes the specified provisional sums, which are added to Row A.</li> <li>Row C is the total amount derived from Row A + Row B.</li> </ul> <p>We are seeking clarification specifically on Row D (Contingency Allowance – 20%):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is the 20% contingency allowance a fixed percentage, or is it allowed up to a maximum of 20%, to be calculated on Row C?</li> <li>Additionally, in the price bid document received, the values for Rows B, C, and D are already filled in.</li> </ol> <p>Kindly confirm whether:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>These values are pre-determined and fixed, or</li> <li>The bidder is required to recalculate or verify these values while submitting the price bid.</li> </ul> <p>Your clarification on the above will help us ensure accurate compliance with the bidding requirements.</p>	<p>Bidders are required to use Annexure-1: Bill of Quantities (BOQ) (Excel format) provided in soft copy / pen drive for filling in their quoted rates for the subject contract. A physical (hard) copy of the duly filled BOQ shall be submitted during tender submission.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The 20% contingency allowance is a fixed percentage.</li> <li>Annexure-1: Bill of Quantities (BOQ) (Excel sheet) is an auto-linked document.</li> </ol> <p>Accordingly, Rows B, C, and D will be recalculated automatically based on the bidder's inputs and do not require manual modification.</p>
